His work helped to run the Knights of Pythias' annual circus, a fundraiser and supporter of many handicapped programs. More than a diligent member of his community he was truly an inspirational leader and sincerely compassionate man.

Often Mr. Zuckerman mentioned, "What do our children do after the summer Special Education schooling and camps? All the other children move onto Fall and Winter sports. Who provides for these children?" Thus, this simple yet prophetic idea was set in motion and Club Fun was born.

Starting in 1996-97 season, the Fair Lawn Special Ed program was renamed the Al Zuckerman Club Fun program. Additionally, the letters "AZ" will adorn the sleeve of our program's shirt in memory of our friend who inspired this innovative and uplifting program.

Route 208 North - Follow Rt. 208N past Nabisco to the 2nd Maple Ave exit. Continue off exit and bear right onto Maple Ave. Continue straight on Maple Ave ½ mile to Fair Lawn Brunswick Lanes on right side
This is Maple Ave South

Route 208 South - Follow Rt. 208S to Maple Ave exit and proceed straight to 2nd stop sign. Make a right onto Maple Ave and continue ½ mile to Fair Lawn Brunswick Lanes on the right.

From New York City:

George Washington Bridge to Route 4 West. Continue to Route 208 North. Exit at Fair Lawn Avenue East. Make a right onto 20th Street and follow to the end of the road.

From South or North:

Route 287 North or South to Route 208 South. Exit at Fair Lawn Avenue. Continue straight through light at end of ramp onto Orchard Street. Make a left onto Berdan Avenue and continue to end. Make a right onto 20th Street.

From West:

Route 80 East to Route 20 North. Exit at Fair Lawn Avenue. Make a right onto Orchard Street. Make a left onto Berdan Avenue and continue to end. Make a right onto 20th Street.

CLUB FUN PROGRAM POLICIES

BOWLING

1. Please make sure to check your child in and wait to receive a lane assignment.
2. Please make sure that you or an adult family member is always at the bowling alley for the entire program.
3. High School volunteers will not be responsible for your child if they leave the numbered alley that is assigned to them.
4. All Club Fun participants must stay by the alley, snack bar, or bathrooms.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: In case of bad weather conditions the Club Fun coordinators will contact parents at their home telephone numbers as soon as we deem the program cancelled. The day will not be made up.
