SNOW REMOVAL AND STREET SALTING
NOTICE

The Department of Public Works would like to advise all residents of their Snow Removal and Street Salting Procedures. Once it starts to snow, the Road Department will dispatch salt trucks to begin salting County Roads* and the Designated Emergency Snow Routes**. After these roads are made safe and passable, the secondary roads will be salted, if it is deemed necessary. This decision will be made based upon continuing weather conditions.

Roads will be plowed in the following order:

1. County Roads* and Designated Snow Emergency Routes**
2. Emergency Service Buildings
3. Secondary Roads
4. Borough Parking Lots

Each snow plow has been assigned a section to plow and remain in that section until all roadways have been sufficiently cleared. This may require the snowplow vehicle to make multiple passes on each street. Borough Snow Removal Vehicles will plow each street curb to curb during each snowfall. On occasion, due to the lack of areas between the sidewalk and curb, sidewalks and driveway aprons may become covered with snow. Borough Snow Removal Vehicles will not remove snow from any sidewalk or driveway apron. We regret this unfortunate inconvenience to all residents.

Pursuant to the Code of the Borough of Fair Lawn §208-2: ***Depositing snow and ice on streets and sidewalks prohibited***. No person, firm or corporation, owner, tenant or occupant of any premises abutting on any street shall throw, place or deposit any snow or ice into or upon any street in the Borough of Fair Lawn. ***THIS ORDINANCE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED!***

Pursuant to the Code of the Borough of Fair Lawn §232-6: ***Parking prohibited for snow removal, snow plowing on certain streets***. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the Emergency Snow Emergency Routes**, until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.

Your cooperation in following the above ordinances will greatly increase our ability to clear the roads of snow and ice in a prompt and timely manner.
