SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES OF JULY 18, 2022
TOUR OF WATER TREATMENT FACILITY
9-14 Cadmus Place – Fair Lawn

Mayor Peluso called the meeting to order at 4:07 p.m.

The Municipal Clerk read the Statement of Compliance of the Open Public Meetings Act notice: "In accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, adequate notice of this special meeting, giving the time, date and location of this public meeting, was submitted to 'The Record' and 'The Herald News' on July 13, 2022, was posted on the bulletin board located on the 1st floor of the Municipal Building, was filed in the Office of the Municipal Clerk, and was posted on the Borough's website. The purpose of the Special Meeting is to tour the Cadmus Place Water Treatment Facility located at 9-14 Cadmus Place, Fair Lawn, New Jersey."

PRESENT: Mayor Peluso, Deputy Mayor Cutrone, Deputy Mayor of Community Affairs Krause (who arrived late at 4:17 p.m.) and Councilmember Rottenstrich. Councilmember Reinitz was absent.

ALSO PRESENT: Borough Manager Van Kruijning, Municipal Clerk Magarelli, CFO Palermo, Chief of Staff Alvarez, Public Works Superintendent Hoitsma and Water Generation Supervisor John Williams.

PUBLIC PRESENT: Mirna Beck, 5-18 Estler Court

Pamela Coles, 13-34 George Street

TOUR OF WATER TREATMENT FACILITY: John Williams provided a tour of the Water Treatment facility, located at 9-14 Cadmus Place. During his tour he explained the nine (9) steps of the Borough's water filtration system. Mr. Williams answered questions from the Governing Body, Borough Representatives and Public throughout the tour.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Due to the nature of the special meeting, it was determined that Public Comment would be in an open forum and will be allowed throughout the tour of the treatment facility.

The following questions were asked by the public to Mr. Williams throughout the tour in which Mr. Williams responded:

Mirna Beck, 5-18 Estler Court:

- Asked the definition of V.O.C.
- Asked what happens with the water filtration in the event of a power outage.
- Asked how often the water quality report is completed and what compounds is the water tested for.
- Asked if our water system handle the vast increase in developments in town.
- Asked about the process using chlorine gas for filtration.

Pamela Coles, 13-34 George Street:

- Asked where the water we process originates from.
- Commented about the freshness of the water sampled.
- Asked if any compounds are added afterwards that would leave a sensation of thirst.

Upon motion by Deputy Mayor Cutrone and a second by Councilmember Rottenstrich, the Special Meeting was adjourned at 5:08 p.m.
