RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR A NJDEP TREATMENT WORKS PERMIT FOR 1 REAGANT LANE, BLOCK 4902, LOT 1

WHEREAS, Fisher Scientific Company, LLC located on Block 4902, Lot 1 being commonly known as 1 Reagent Lane, Fair Lawn, New Jersey is submitting an application for a General Industrial Treatment Works Approval ("TWA") to install and operate a temporary construction dewatering treatment system (the "Project" at 1 Reagent Lane, Fair Lawn, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, in order for Fisher Scientific Company, LLC to submit the TWA application, the Borough is required to authorize consent to Fisher Scientific Company, LLC, confirm the Project complies with Borough Ordinances and to authorize the Mayor to certify as part of the TWA application for the Project, and good cause having been shown that the authorization for such certification required is necessary for the Project and appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Fair Lawn, in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1) That the references and definitions used in the recitals above are hereby included as part of this Resolution.
- 2) That the Borough consents to permit Fisher Scientific Company, LLC to apply for a TWA for the Project and the Project complies with the applicable Borough ordinances.
- 3) That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a certification as required for the TWA application; and
