### **EQUIPMENT**

All players are required to supply their own equipment including; a stick, helmet with a protective cage, gloves and shin guards. Players must wear comfortable sneakers; no boots or cleats will be allowed. Players will receive a team jersey.

### **PRACTICE & GAMES**

Team practices for the Junior and Senior Divisions will take place during the week at the discretion of each volunteer coach. All games are played on the weekend in Memorial Park. Games will begin in December and continue until the end of February (weather permitting). The games will be played on the Bredehorst Court (Large Court).

### **JUNIOR & SENIOR DIVISION TRYOUTS**

Any new players in the Junior and Senior Divisions will have to attend a tryout. Players will be drafted onto a team. If a player misses the tryout, he/she will be placed on a team.

### **PEE WEE LEAGUE (1<sup>ST</sup>- 4<sup>TH</sup> GRADE)**

Pee Wee Hockey is an instructional league only. Players will be placed on a team and will play on **Saturday mornings** between hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on the Gambucci Court (Small Court).
